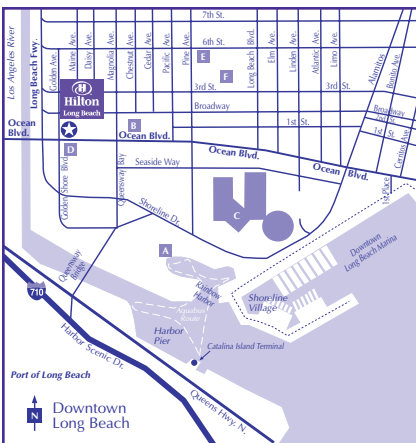
Who Should Attend: Physicians, Nurses, Respiratory Therapists, Physical Therapists, and other allied healthcare professionals.
